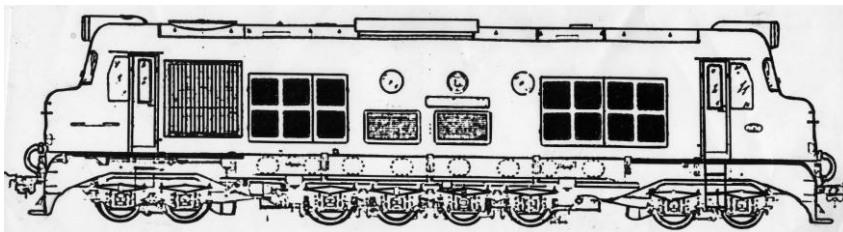
The Society's financial year ends on the 30<sup>th</sup> April each year and if joining between November and April, you pay only half the membership fee initially.
