"Prospector" trailer

Trailer car WCE922

Overall length approx 27.43m

Weight empty approx 50.4 tonnes

Currently located at Kewdale.

This is an unpowered trailer car from the Prospector trains which ran Perth-Kalgoorlie from 1970-2005. It had 64 seats.

Rail Heritage WA also has a WCA car, motorised but otherwise matching this trailer, which we intend to display in our museum.



VW 348

Type: Workman's van. Formerly passenger carriage class AR then class ARS. 6-wheel bogies.

Location: Bassendean

Origin: Built in 1908 by WAGR

Tare weight (in original condition with bogies): 29 tonnes

Length over couplers: 18.8 metres

Width: 2.7 metres

Height (on bogies): 3.7 metres

Rail Heritage WA welcomes Expressions of Interest for these historic railway locomotives and rolling stock –

Parties submitting an expression of interest should note the following:

1. Expressions should identify
 - a. proposed location
 - b. restoration intention and abilities
 - c. who will be responsible
 - d. what is offered in return
 - e. whether sale/loan/lease is proposed
 - f. how soon they can take item
2. Offers for locomotives, or for items which we have restored, will be expected to provide some return to Rail Heritage WA
3. These items are offered “as is” and “where is”. Transport, restoration and insurance are the responsibility of the party taking the item
4. The highest, or any, offer will not necessarily be accepted. Rail Heritage WA will also consider the intent of the person expressing interest, the likelihood of their success, their proposed location for the vehicle and all other information as requested in item 2 above.
5. No offer will be accepted until the party making the offer has inspected the item(s).
